- Recreating in Vermont's forests

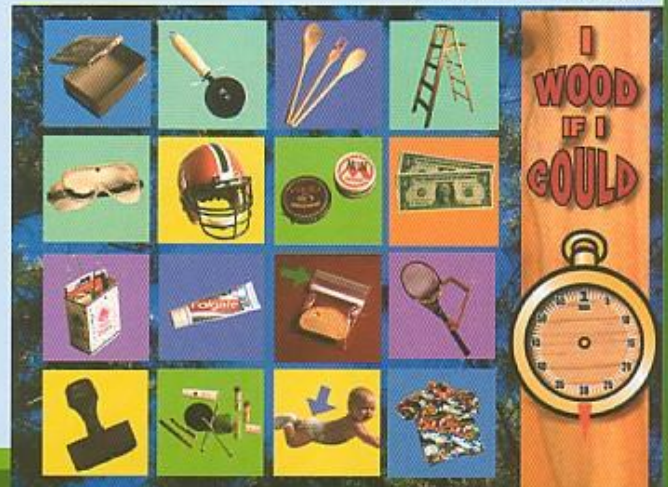
### The CD features

- Take a pre- and post-test to check their forest knowledge.

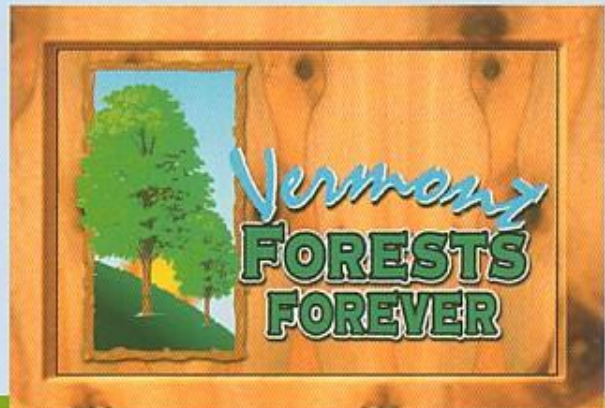
